Uninstall previous versions of the SAS software from your computer with Add/Remove program in the control panel. Then, delete any SAS icons from your desktop and erase any remaining SAS software from the Program Files directory.

Close all nonessential applications.

Insert the CD-ROM labeled Setup Disk into the source drive. If AutoPlay does not work, select the RUN menu option in the Windows Start menu and type:

<source_drive>:\SETUP where <source_drive> is the drive containing the installation CD/diskette.

Updating to Minimum System Requirements

On the SAS Product Installation screen, select System Requirements Wizard from options list. Follow the wizard prompts to ensure your system will run SAS. Reboot at prompt.

Starting the SAS System Installation Process

On the SAS Product Installation screen, select SAS System Setup.


1. Click **Next** when the Welcome screen appears.

If the Release Information screen appears, click Next and skip to Step 4.

- Verify that **Custom** installation is selected and click **Next**.
- Accept the defaults on the next 5 screens.
- On the **Solutions** screen, click **Customize**.



- On the **Custom Installation** screen, choose the components to install.
See list of recommended components shown below the following figure:



Click Next when done.

Recommended Components

- In the **Review Installation Choices** dialog, verify your choices. Use the **Back** button to make any needed corrections. If none are needed, click **Next**.

SAS Setup will now begin copying files and creating the SAS System Installation. Insert disks as prompted.

To change the default locations of the SAS files:

1. Open \Program Files\SAS Institute\SAS\V8\SASV8.cfg file in a text editor like NotePad or Kedit.
2. Modify the file that follows -SET MYSASFILES to your preferred system variable folder.
3. Modify the file that follows -SASUSER to your user profile folder.
4. Insert a new line following the SASUSER lines that reads:
-SASINITIALFOLDER d:/file name
where d: is the drive location and the filename is your preferred initial folder.
5. Save your changes and close text editor.
